Best Practice No.1

Title of Practice:- Covid 19 Vaccination Camp for Students and Senior Citizens

Context:- During the covid 19 most of the people have been affected very badly in terms of health and money. In order to rejuvenate their working efficiency and stimulating their immunating power the vaccination camp was conducted in the college premises.

Objectives:-

1. To increase the immunity power of the students and senior citizens.
2. To remove the fear psychology from the mind of the students and senior citizens.

Practice:- Considering the pandemic situation and to secure the health of the students, the free Covid19 vaccination camp was organized in collaboration with Primary Health Center, Karanjvihare, Chakan. 2. The problem faced is below 18 year students couldn't be vaccinated.

2. The students who have completed 2 doses of Covid 19 can attend the physical lectures in the college.



Best Practice No.2

Title of Practice:- Free distribution of ration kit under "Kai.Bhagubai Pingle Annadan Yojana".

Context:- During the covid 19 most of the people have been affected and lost their employment. The free ration kit distribution camp was organised for rations and daily usable items to the daily wage MIDC workers who have lost their jobs in the nearby areas.

Objectives:-

1. To help the poor family of daily wage workers by providing the free Ration Kit of daily need items
2. To fulfill the basic food requirements of their families

Practice:- As a part of the social responsibility the college conducted Free Ration Distribution Camp in Collaboration with NavSahyadri Charitable Trust, Pune. The college has created the two groups of the students and faculty members on is for ration collection and other is for ration distribution. Toatal 04 faculty members and 10 students are assigned for this purpose. To get the requisite quantity of the ration the college had appealed the students, staff, alumni and established shop owners to donate the ration, food and daily usable items as much as possible. All of the appealed people respond positively and contributed as per their capability. More than 200 ration Kits were distributed to the families of the daily wage workers working in the Chakan MIDC area.

Obstacles Faced:-

1. The main problem faced by the college to distribute the ration items to the needy people was local logistics.
2. Following or Maintaining the protocols of Covid 19 was also difficult to carried out the activity.

Impact:-

1. The basic needs of the jobless workers had been fulfilled.
2. The students get an opportunity to know their social responsibility and contribute as per their capability.
