Terms of the MoU

GENERAL REGULATIONS, ELIGIBILITY AND ENROLMENT

1. The two parties agree to enter into a student exchange agreement, commencing in the academic year **2019-2024**
2. The participating students and faculty will register at the host institution for the full academic year or for a minimum of one academic term.
3. Each institution may send up to **25** students and **10** faculty per academic year to participate in the exchange. The number of participants may be increased subject to the mutual agreement of both institutes.
4. It is expected that in any given year there will be an equal number of students exchanged from each institution. The number of faculty also equal for the faculty exchange program.
5. Notwithstanding Clauses 3 and 4 above, while equal numbers in every year may not be possible, efforts will be made to have equal numbers exchanged over a five-year period.

6. The participant will be students who are completing an undergraduate program or graduate program at their respective institutions.
7. The participants will be selected by their respective institutions to participate in the exchange. Candidates must satisfy admission requirements for special student status, including language proficiency requirements, of the host institution or the host department.
8. Participants in the faculty exchange will be required to have completed at least one year of teaching experience prior to participation in the exchange. Participating graduate students should have completed at least one term of studies at the home institutes.
9. Each institution will appoint an individual to act as the coordinator for the exchange. The exchange is coordinated in both institutes through **coordinator**.
10. The host institutions will have the right of refusal of any candidate who may appear to be unacceptable for the exchange.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

11. The home institution will pay the travelling allowance for the respective faculty- students exchange program at the home institution to the travelling for the host institution for.
12. The attendance of students is compulsory for every session.

RESOURCES AND REGULATIONS AT THE HOST INSTITUTION


13. The topic as per the curriculum and class and time-table for the faculty and student exchange program will be decided by the host institute by making coordination with other institution.
14. At the end of the academic year, the participants in the exchange will request the host institution to send to the home institution a report/official transcript of their academic achievement.
15. Each participant in the exchange must ensure that they have adequate health and accident insurance coverage.
16. Exchange students are subject to the rules and regulations of the host institution. The host institution reserves the right to dismiss any participating student at any time for academic or personal misconduct. The dismissal of a participant shall not abrogate the agreement for the arrangements regarding other participants.

DURATION, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT

17. The parties will review the terms of the MOU annually to assess the success of the exchange, and will determine whether to continue, modify or discontinue the MOU. Each party reserves the right to terminate this MOU upon six months written notice to the other. Any exchanges of students taking place at the time of termination will not be affected; exchange students who already stay at the host institution will be allowed to complete the exchange program.
18. This MOU shall take effect when signed by both parties, and will remain in effect for a period of **five years**. Thereafter, it has to be renewed for another period.



TO WIT:

The purpose of this agreement is to reduce to writing the agreement and understanding to provide mental health services for the July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2024 academic year. Ultimately the goal of the agreement is to develop a collaborative partnership between the two parties to meet the educational and mental health needs of the College Students collectively served by both parties.

I. General Terms and Conditions

The general terms of this agreement are that the First Party will provide infrastructure and reasonable access to identified students for the purposes of the Second Party to provide mental health services to those identified Students, more particularly stated herein.

To accomplish the purpose of this agreement, the parties do agree as follows:

A. Termination:

1. Either party may terminate this agreement, with or without cause, at any time by giving at least a thirty (30) day advance notice to the other party of its intent to terminate this Agreement.

B. Procedure:

1. To establish, prior to offering services to any student, a protocol for making referrals, establishing lines of communication regarding referral status and role/responsibility of each party in this process. This will ensure an understanding by all parties of the process and assures successful collaboration in meeting student needs.
2. The agreed upon protocol will be effective for the current Academic Year and may extend to depending on needs and resources. All parties will possess a written copy of Protocol. If either party wishes to change or alter the protocol during the year, a meeting can be called with representatives from both parties to discuss and come to agreement upon proposed changes at any time.

II. Confidentiality

The Provider by signing this agreement,

- A. Assures that any information received from the **Navsahyadri Charitable Trust College of Education (B.Ed. & M.Ed.) Chakan & Manshakti Kendra, Chakan** relating to individuals on public assistance applicants and/or recipients will be maintained as confidential and will not be copied or given to any other governmental agency, individual or private concerns without written permission of the Cabinet or the applicant or recipient,
- B. Takes all precautions to assure that information is safeguarded and to maintain security over such information to assure it does not become available to unauthorized individuals;

III. CONFIDENTIALITY OF EDUCATION INFORMATION

The Provider assures the confidentiality of all personally identifiable information, written and verbal, provided by or about any student receiving services under this agreement, and shall not release any information to a third party other than the College.

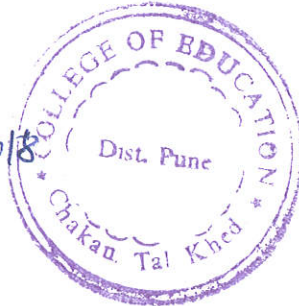

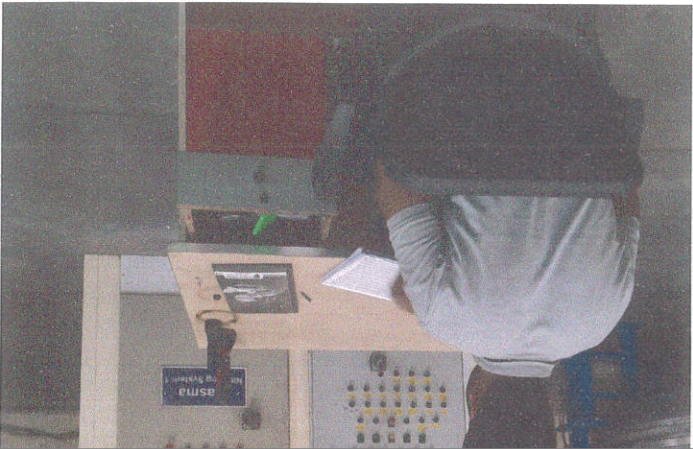

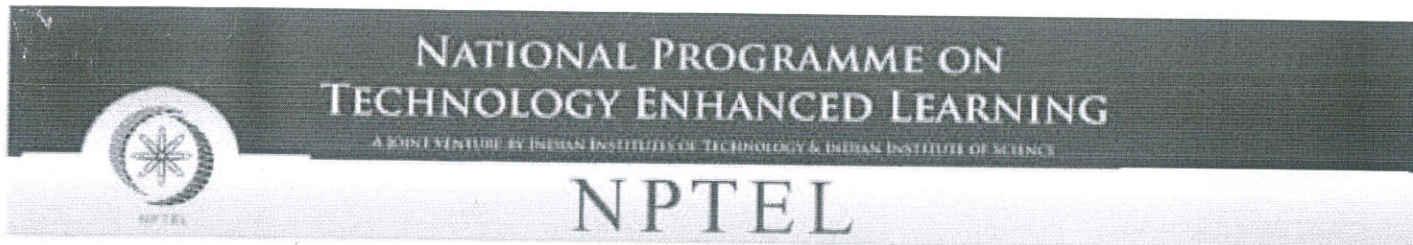
